Local artisans to showcase their works every Saturday this summer at **The Ironworks Arts and Events Centre in Clarksburg at 108 George Street.**

Beginning July 3rd artists and craftspeople will be showing and selling their handcrafted items in an **outdoor** garden setting at **The Ironworks**. The **Saturday Artisans Market** is a new attraction in the Gallery District of the village of Clarksburg, also known as “Artsburg” and will run throughout the summer months.

“I wanted to provide a welcoming outdoor setting for people to meet local artists,” says Michael Pocock, owner and operator for 15 years of **The Ironworks**. “It will be a friendly atmosphere for artists and visitors to discuss new ideas and products in a public forum.

The Ironworks Arts and Events Centre is a short walk from the main street of Clarksburg and beside the Beaver River Walking Trail.

Michael Pocock, a metal sculptor and furniture designer, has transformed this once industrial setting into a people-friendly centre where he creates and displays his own works. He has landscaped the grounds with gatherings in mind and is eager to share his space with fellow artists and village visitors. The **Saturday Artisans Market** is an integral part of Pocock’s vision for **The Ironworks**, as part of the village of Clarksburg in the Town of Blue Mountains!
